FEES:

Entry fees are \$3.00 per entry for Littles, all youth and adults, with the following exceptions:

Honorary (Senior Citizens - 65+) \$1.00

Nursing home entrants – no fee

Special Citizens – no fee

Veterans – no fee **THANK YOU** for your **Services!**

School groups are \$2 per entry, per student.

1. Three entries per class will be allowed in all divisions.
2. Two copies of Division Entry Forms are needed for each entry with fee. See Division page in catalog for all information.
3. You are required to read and follow all rules and instructions and initial entry form to compete.
4. The entry must be made by exhibitor, entered in correct age group and completed within the last two years.
5. Entries from a previous year are not eligible for exhibit.
6. Competition in this department is open to **Hunt and Surrounding Counties.**
7. Exhibits will be judged by the American Judging System: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place – all others will be awarded participation ribbons.
8. Blue ribbon winners in each class will compete for rosettes. Blue rosettes in each division will compete for Best Show. These will be awarded after all judging is complete.
9. Exhibits **MUST** stay in place until end of Fair. Ribbon will be forfeited if exhibit is picked up early.
10. The Fair Association and Creative Arts Department will exercise all due diligence to prevent damage or loss of articles. Articles are entered at owners' risk.
11. Soiled, dingy or damaged items will not be accepted for display or competition.
12. The Chairman of each division will determine placement with each exhibit.
13. The Chairman has authority to combine or delete classes.
14. The subject matter of entries must be suitable for family viewing under the discretion of the Creative Arts Department.

NO GLASS OR HEAVY FRAMES ARE ALLOW WITH FINE ARTS AND PHOTOGRAPHY.
